By signing this code of conduct, I agree that I will abide by the following statements during my time as a coach of Elevation Athletics:

- At all times, adhere to the USA Swimming rules and code of conduct.
- Set the highest standard possible for professional respect and sportsmanship for all athletes, participants, parents and fans of the sport of swimming to follow.
- Always act professional, with dignity, humility and honor.
- Respect officials and their judgement. Abide by the rules of the competition or event and speak respectfully with the official should I disagree with their call.
- Always treat coaches, athletes and parents from other teams with the utmost respect and dignity.
- Coach the EA program to my best ability.
- Continually educate myself every day to improve the quality of my understanding of the sport and incorporate this new information into my training philosophy in a productive way.
- Instruct all EA members in sportsmanship, personal leadership, life skills and personal development and display great qualities in each area at all times as well.
- Coach in a productive, positive manner and not use derogatory, demeaning or abusive language.
- Treat every athlete and parent fairly, justly, impartially, intelligently and with appropriate sensitivity.
- Always place the well-being, health, and safety of the EA athletes & families above all other considerations.
- Communicate effectively with all EA members.
- Follow all Safe Sport rules and regulations.
- Always maintain a professional separation between athlete and coach & parent and coach.

Any complaints of a coach violating this code of conduct will be brought to the attention of Grant Holicky first. If not adequately justified, the remaining coaching staff may be brought in to rectify the situation.
